### UNIVERSITY HEALTH SERVICES

This service provides support to the University community: students, families, faculty and administrative staff members. The UHS provides a wide variety of services, from primary health care to off-hours urgent and non-urgent care. Besides medical care and critical care assessment, UHS offers referrals to local physicians and to the SGU Counseling services.

### CLINIC LOCATION

The clinic is located on the main campus in Building Z at the opposite end of the student mailroom.

### HOURS OF OPERATION

The clinic is open Monday through Friday from 8:30AM to 4:30PM with an hour off for lunch depending upon patient traffic. Physicians are in attendance from 9AM to 4:00PM. Vaccinations are administered in the afternoons. Routine blood work is drawn on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays between 8:30-10:00 AM.

### OFF HOURS

A Physician and a Physician Extender are on call from 4:30PM – 8:00AM Monday through Friday and 24 hours on weekends and holidays.

### OFF HOURS

These providers are reached by calling the Resident Assistant – if you are an on-campus student – or by contacting the campus security if you are off-campus (444-3898 or 3883 or 4456) or 777.

### ACUTE CARE

All acute care cases are referred to the Grenada General Hospital or to a local private clinic. Occasionally, cases are referred to Trinidad, Barbados, or to the United States.

### SERVICE COSTS

UHS services are free for all SGU students, faculty, administrative staff and their immediate families. Laboratory work sent out, medications, and vaccinations are charged to the patient at cost.
